Background

ELEANA Patras branch aimed to explain multimorbidity's impact on rheumatic diseases, inspiring the creation of a Health Festival

Objectives

- Collaboration: Local health associations engaged in a scenic, relaxing venue
- Diverse Participation: 38 associations offered health resources at individual booths

Educational Material Distribution:

Brochures and materials were shared, with doctors on-site for Q&A sessions

Health Screenings:

Mobile units offered:

- Blood donation, ultrasounds, breast exams, allergy and blood sugar tests
- Rheumatologic, dental, and pediatric eye exams
- Lectures and Presentations:

Health associations hosted talks in a dedicated area

Art and Child Activities:

Art exhibits and interactive activities created a familyfriendly vibe with live music

Recreational Programs:

Kids enjoyed sports, theater, games, and face painting

Fundraising Bazaar:

Associations held a bazaar to support their causes





OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES

Results 1st year

- 130 breast exams
- 80 pediatric screenings
- 56 ultrasounds
- 16 allergy test
- 42 Capillary blood glucose monitoring (CBG)
- 40 rheumatologic tests



Results 4th year

- 390 breast exams
- 320 pediatric screenings
- 168 ultrasounds
- 70 allergy tests
- 140 Capillary blood glucose monitoring (CBG)
- 200 rheumatologic tests
